Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts is substituting for Dr. Jane Teichner.

Administrative Hearings:

On Tuesday September 22, 2015 Steward Jack Houghton Jr. met with trainer Mr. Ramon Preciado in the Salix Office, to send a split sample #15331 collected on August 26, 2015 that was returned positive for "Clenbuterol," concerning the horse "Trouble Kid," who was the winner of the first race on Wednesday, August 26, 2015. Mr. Preciado requested that the split sample be sent to Industrial Labs in Wheat Ridge Colorado.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Sample #14838 collected on September 2, 2015 which had been placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was cleared.
- Sample #14846 collected on September 5, 2015 which was previously placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was cleared.
- Samples #14461 and #14822 collected on September 7, 2015 which were placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis were cleared.
- Samples collected on September 12, and 14, 2015 were cleared with the exception of #15303 and #15376 collected on September 12, 2015 which were placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #10, Stacey's Pumpkin," was a vet scratch. #4, "Samara I Am," stumbled at the start. #5, "Hello Emmie," broke slowly.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #3, “Noble Master,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. Hector Caballero, named on #5, “I Wanda Win,” was changed to Adam Bowman; no double jocks mount. #1, “Legal Punch,” was scratched as a main-track only. #3, “Sky Above,” and #6, “Wild Woo Who,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2, “Hugh and Me,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 10 - 2.” Starters - 8

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. Taylor Hole, scheduled to ride #6, “She’salittlekeeper,” was changed to Christen Santiago Reyes; no double jocks mount. #5, “Michelle,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #6, “She’salittlekeeper,” stumbled at the start.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 8

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:22 p.m. #6, “Crimson Valor,” was scratched as a main-track only. #1, “River Running,” was pulled up shortly after the start. The #1 was walked off the racing surface by the outrider. We interviewed jockey Jose Lopez the rider of the #1, “River Running,” why he pulled the horse up, he said the horse did not feel right, and was not travelling well so he pulled him up.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 11 - 4 - 8.” Starters - 11

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. Carlos Luis Gutierrez, named on #3, “Just Irish,” was changed to Jomar Ortega; no double jocks mount. **HOLD AND CLAIM OF FOUL** by jockey Mario Rodriguez rider of the #1, “Isolation Road,” against the #2, “Punster,” ridden by Jose Lopez. The claim of foul was in reference to the #3, “Punster,” coming over and making it tight on the #1, “Isolation Road,” during the run at the three-eighths pole and forcing jockey Rodriguez to check his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official as the #3 never came in during the run at the three-eighths pole. No inquiry was called by the Stewards into the running of this race. After a two way shake, #2, “Punster,” was claimed by Jagger Inc – Jamie Ness.

ORDER OF FINISH – “(2 4) - 1 - 7 - 3.” Dead-Heat for the win 2-4: Starters - 7

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:26 p.m. Tyler Conner, named on #10, “Noble Road,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #1, “Street Bullet,” and #3, “Noteworthy Peach,” were scratched as a main-track only. #13, “I. C. Lightning,” and #14, “No Fear (IRE),” were scratched as alternates. #2, “Act of Madness,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The connections that claimed the #2, “Act of Madness,” requested a \$113.00 all inclusive special test.

Mario Rodriguez, named on #5, “Deadly Card,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. #1, “El Bagre,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #3, “Motin,” was claimed by Isaias Garcia Cortez – Alejandro Reyes.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 8

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:27 p.m. Maria Remedio scheduled to ride #1, “All N All,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. #1a, “In X Hess,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Throughleap,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
