Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All samples collected on September 16, 2015 were cleared.
- Samples #15366 and #15381 which were previously placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis were cleared.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Mario Rodriguez, scheduled to ride #4, “Squared Away,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. Daniel Centeno, named on #6, “Hanky Doodle,” was changed to Carol Ceden; no double jocks mount. #6, “Hanky Doodle,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #6, “Hanky Doodle,” was claimed by Rising Sun Racing Stables Inc. – Greg Sacco.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Eriluis Vaz, scheduled to ride #5, “Miss Prudence,” was changed to Tammi Piermarini; no double jocks mount. Mario Rodriguez, named on #6, “Florida Cowgirl,” was changed to Alex Canchari; no double jocks mount. Brian Pedroza, scheduled to ride #7, “No See Um,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount.

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m.

Andrew Wolfson scheduled to ride #1a, “Jersey’s Quatorze,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. #6, “Beautiful Bernice,” and #9, “Highland Dancer,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **HOLD AND CLAIM OF FOUL** by jockey Alex Cintron rider of the #3, “Smuggling,” against the #2, “Make Big Money,” ridden by Janelle Campbell. The claim of foul was in reference to the #2, “Make Big Money,” coming out bumping the #3, “Smuggling,” during the stretch run. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official as the #2 did not come out during the stretch run and was never close to the #3. No inquiry was called by the Stewards into the running of this race.

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:51 p.m. Mario Rodriguez, scheduled to ride #6, “Hidden Blitz,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. #3, “Dilatory,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Dragon Attack,” was claimed by Ridenjac Racing – Dennis Ward.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 6

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:22 p.m. #2, “Stormy Monse,” and #4, “Lil’ Smartiepants,” were vet scratches. #3, “Take It Inside,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:55 p.m. Mario Rodriguez, named on #6, “French Paradox,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. #3, “Talinsky,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:26 p.m. Mario Rodriguez, scheduled to ride #10, “Francesco Punch,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. Angel Serpa, named on #11, “Capital Fellow,” was changed to Alex Canchari; no double jocks mount. #4, “Balino,” was a vet scratch. #1a, “Pulling Away,” #5, “Tappinintovictory,” and #6, “My Son Ernie,” were scratched as main-track only. #10, “Francesco Punch,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 3 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 8

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:56 p.m. #6, “Fiery Cat,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #2, “Street Spin Miss,” was scratched by the Stewards on the advice of Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner who said the horse flipped in the paddock hitting its head twice. The trainer of the #2 Mark Shuman called the Stewards demanding that another vet look at the #2, “Street Spin Miss,” that all the horse had done was run into the wall and did not flip or hit her head. Mr. Shuman was informed that was not possible. Mr. Shuman informed the Stewards that he was going to file a complaint against Dr Teichner with the Racing Commission.
