Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing today on a written protest by owner Sharee Miranda, concerning the claim of the horse “Motin” from the 8th race on Wednesday, September 23, 2015 by owner Isaias Garcia Cortez. After hearing all testimony involved in the case, the Stewards **“VOIDED”** the claim as Mr. Cortez had close contact with the horse when taking the horse to the paddock and test barn after the horse had run in and won a previous race as a groom.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. Paco Lopez, scheduled to ride #5, “Buon Gusto,” was changed to Tyler Conner; no double jocks mount. #2, “Runaway Bull,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 6

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. Angel Serpa, named on #4, “Stormy Alex,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #2, “Smart and Sensible,” was claimed by Black Cloud Racing LLC – Anthony Pecoraro.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #1, “Lady Con Con,” was scratched by the Stewards. #5, “Robin’s Kisses,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 5

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. Keiber Coa, named on #7, “War Hitch,” was changed to Vince Halliday; no double jocks mount. #10, “Irish Brew,” and #11, “Pro Prospect,” were scratched as main-track only.

INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. Hold and claim of foul by the trainer Anthony Pecoraro and jockey Brian Pedroza of the #1, “Cee ‘n O,” against the #4, “Sky Above,” ridden by Alex Cintron. The claim of foul was in reference to the #4, “Sky Above,” coming out in front of the #1, “Cee ‘n O,” during the stretch run causing jockey Pedroza to check his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #4, “Sky Above,” from first, for coming out in front of the #1, “Cee ‘n O,” during the stretch run and placed him third. Consequently, the #1, “Cee ‘n O,” was moved up to second. #2, “Five Shadwell,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #1, “Cee ‘n O,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The connections that claimed the #1, “Cee ‘n O,” requested a \$113.00 all inclusive special test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 4 – (7 8).” Dead-Heat for fourth 7-8: Starters - 9

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. Keiber Coa, scheduled to ride #4, “Russian Vodka,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount.

INQUIRY AT THE HALF MILE POLE - The #8, “Harley’s Joy,” with rider Narciso Cruz came in at the half mile pole causing the #7, “Our Lucky Lady,” with rider Mario Rodriguez to check his horse. No hold or claim of foul was lodged in this race. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #8, from third and placed him fourth for coming over in front of the #7, at the half-mile pole moving the #7, up to third. #8, “Harley’s Joy,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #6, “Beautiful Tashy,” was claimed by Hugh Robertson – Campbell Wilson.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 9

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m. Keiber Coa, named on #2, “Peppi the Hunter,” was changed to Alex Canchari; no double jocks mount. Gabriel Saez, scheduled to ride #4, “J W Racer,” was changed to Sheldon Russell; no double jocks mount. Abel Castellano Jr. named on #5, “Gotta Be Gold,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #7, “Don Ave,” and #8, “Welcome Fairbanks,” were vet scratches.
