Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 29, 2015 for trainer Mr. Raymond (Skip) Einhorn concerning his entering the horse “Sandman Cometh” at two different tracks within the five day entry period. Mr. Einhorn scratched his horse at Delaware Park, from the 5th race on Monday, September 14, 2015 while running the horse at Monmouth Park race track on Sunday, September 13, 2015. Mr. Einhorn will be fined the sum of \$1,000.00 for this violation of D.T.R.C. rules 3.4, 3.4.1.15 and 11.2.12.

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 29, 2015 for trainer Thomas Iannotti IV concerning his entering the horse “Retire Fifty Five” at two different tracks within the five day entry period. Mr. Iannotti scratched his horse at Delaware Park, from the 3rd race on Monday, September 14, 2015 while running the horse at Laurel Park race track on Saturday September 12, 2015. Mr. Iannotti will be fined the sum of \$1,000.00 for this violation of D.T.R.C. rules 3.4, 3.4.1.15 and 11.2.12

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 29, 2015 for trainer Mr. Jeremiah Englehart concerning the scratch of the horse “Liam’s Prince” in the 7th race on Monday, September 14, 2015 due to the horse have the wrong shoes on for the turf course. Mr. Englehart will be fined \$500.00 dollars for this turf shoe violation.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Sample #15303 collected on September 12, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was returned positive for “Clenbuterol.” This sample was collected from “Jake N Elwood,” the winner of the 3rd race on September 12, 2015. Ramon Preciado the trainer of record was informed of the positive at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday September 29, 2015. Trainer Preciado has indicated he will exercise his rights to send a split sample.

- Sample #15376, taken from the horse “Galiana” which ran in the 6th race on Saturday, August 12, 2015, contained a combination of “Flunixin” and “Phenylbutazone.” The trainer of record, Rodolfo Romero, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC personnel conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Romero’s assigned barn area. Results of the search revealed hypodermic needles, and hypodermic syringes. All horses trained and entered by Mr. Romero, will be scratched. As it pertains to the positive test, Mr. Romero waived his right to a hearing and will be fined \$500.00 dollars for a first offense under DTRC rules 15.20 and 15.20.1.
- All samples collected on September 19, 2015 are clear, with the exception of samples #15148 and #15351 which were placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- All samples collected on September 21, 2015 are clear, with the exception of samples #15162 and #15191 which were placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #2, “Dr. Wesley,” was a vet scratch. #3, “D K Edge was claimed by Home Team Stables – Scott Lake. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #1, “Visionary Wonder,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m.

#1, “Tappinintovictory,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Key to a Cure,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Tuckers Point,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1a - 7 - 3.” Starters - 6

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #3, “Winter,” broke slowly.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 9 - 6.” Starters - 9

FIFTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m.

Eriluis Vaz, scheduled to ride #9, “Karfagen,” was changed to Edwin Rivera; no double jocks mount. Wilfredo Corujo, named on #10, “Cumberland Gap,” was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Champagne Chic,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2, “Ziwiye,” and #10, “Fasque,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #1, “Dubh,” and #8, “Nekia’s Edge,” were scratched by their trainers on account of track conditions. #11, “Springers Point,” was scratched as an alternate. #3, “R B Rainbow Dash,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #6, “Chocolate Wildcat,” broke slowly.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 9 - 11 - 5.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:57 p.m. Nik Juarez, named on #11, “Awesome Group,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. Scott Spieth, scheduled to ride #7, “Hobson B,” indicated that he did not want to ride this horse as he did not like the way it was warming up. Spieth was replaced by Alex Canchari. There was no double jocks mount in this change. Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown called the Stewards after examining the #7, “Hobson B,” stating that the #7 horse looked ok to run. We experienced a nine minute delay in the start of this race waiting for the rider change on the #7. #8, “Oshie,” was scratched by its trainer due to track conditions. #9, “Onthewhistle,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 9 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 12

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:29 p.m. #6, “Lemon de Oro,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #13, “Panzime,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Miss Thursday,” #3, “Miss Giacomo,” #8, “My Jolie (IRE),” #10, “Queenofzeenile,” #11, “Abracadabra,” and #14, “Ava Again,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf.. #5, “Banjo Cat,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:58 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:59 p.m. J D Acosta, scheduled to ride #2, “Beau Who,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #1, “Longer Terms Doug,” and #4, “Incomprehensible,” were vet scratches.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 8 - 5.” Starters - 7

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:30 p.m. Horatio Karamanos, named on #5, “Skestos,” was changed to Sheldon Russell; no double jocks mount. #3, “Newscast,” was claimed by Helen Marshall – Kieron Magee.
