Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

• Sample #15376, collected from the horse “Galiana” which ran and won in the 6th race on Saturday, August 12, 2015, contained a combination of “Flunixin” and “Phenylbutazone.” The trainer of record, Rodolfo Romero, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. Trainer Romero has waived his right to a hearing in this matter and will be issued a \$500.00 fine. Refer to D.T.R.C. stacking rules 15.20 and 15.21.1. Trainer Romero remains suspended pending a Stewards hearing on the administrative charges of being in possession of hypodermic materials during an investigation handled by the DTRC on 9-29-15.

Administrative

We learned today that Parx Race Track’s stable area is under quarantine for Equine Herpes Virus, with no horses being able to ship in or out. Restrictions on horses leaving or returning from Parx are in place.

#2, “Jazzysdudeaintrude,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Star of Magic,” was scratched by its trainer as the horse is stabled at Parx. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #4, “Motin,” hopped out of the gate breaking slowly.

Raoul Dygas, scheduled to ride #2, “Littlebuzz,” was changed to Vladimir Cespede. Solange Gourdain, named on #3, “Formal N Fast” was changed to Tais Lyapustina. Etienne Merle, scheduled to ride #8, “Drumlsh,” was changed to Jerry Ortega. The rider on the #11, “Opio,” will be Christopher Ortiz. #4, “Artistic Intention,” #5, “Sloneker’s Star,” #6, “Middle Road,” #7, “Northampton Kid,” and #10, “Hardly Patient,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #12, “Slews Love,” #13,

“Seventh Chapter,” and #14, “Indy Buzzz,” were scratched as alternates. #1, “Miss Modela,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 1 - 2 - 11.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #1, “Piercinator,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:55 p.m. Alex Canchari, named on #4, “Subtle Intent,” was changed to Robert Paz.; a losing double jocks mount will be charged. The #4 was returned to the paddock for a change of riders, as jockey Canchari was thrown out the back of the gate by the horse when it reared up getting the wind knocked out of him. Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown reported to the Stewards after examining the #4, “Subtle Intent,” stating that the horse looked fine to run. We experienced a nine-minute delay in the start of this race waiting for the rider change on the #4. #3, “Aprilonthemoney,” and #7, “Graced With Power,” were scratched by their trainers as the horses are stabled at Parx. #6, “Madonna’s Conquest,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #5, “Silver Bouquet,” was claimed by Worcester Investments LLC – Wayne Potts. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 5

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:23 p.m. #1, “Decesion Point,” #1a, “Jr.’s Chili Pepper,” #5, “Bomb Site,” and #7, “Wholly Hughs,” were scratched by their trainers on account of track conditions. #3, “Atlantic Surfer,” was scratched by its trainer as the horse is stabled at Parx. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests.

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. #7, “Surge Ahead,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #8, “Way of the Warrior,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #9, “Venetian Cat,” was claimed by Worcester Investments LLC – Wayne Potts.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 9 - 2.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:21 p.m. Gerald Almodovar, scheduled to ride #9, “Wicked Heart,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. #1, “Odlum,” #3, “Ebreeq,” #4, “Max Crown,” #5, “Et Al,” #6, “Jewish Holiday,” and #14, “Cruise More,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf.

ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 13 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 8

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:50 p.m. #2, “Showmeister,” was scratched by its trainer due to track conditions. #4, “Synchronous,” was scratched by its trainer as the horse is stabled at Parx. #8, “Ghostbuster,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:19 p.m. Kali Francois, named on #1, “Brave Titan,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. Keiber Coa, scheduled to ride #4, “Easy Ten,” was changed to Travis Wales; no double jocks mount. #2, “Alsace,” was scratched by its trainer as the horse is stabled at Parx. #8, “Spare the Kid,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. After a three-way shake, #4, “Easy Ten,” was claimed by Andrew Simoff – Owner Trainer. On another claim, following a two-way shake, #5, “Beauziggity,” was claimed by Anthracite Racing – Sam Cronk. Lastly, on another two-way shake, #6, “Pea Shooter Pro,” was claimed by Maria Claire Van Sant – David Nunn.
