Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Sample #14813 collected on September 23, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was returned positive for “Flunixin.” This sample was collected from “Agonistic,” the winner of the 3rd race on September 23, 2015. Ronald B. Abrams, the trainer of record was informed of the positive at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday October 10, 2015. Trainer Abrams waived his right to a hearing and will accept the penalty of a \$500.00 fine for a first offense of DTRC stacking rule 15.20 -15.20.1.
- Sample #14445 collected on September 23, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was returned positive for “Flunixin and Methocarbamol.” This sample was collected from “Pontius P,” the winner of the 5th race on September 23, 2015. Keith C. Dickey the trainer of record was informed of the positive at 10:10 a.m. on Saturday October 10, 2015. Trainer Dickey waived his right to a hearing and will accept the penalty of a \$500.00 fine for a first offense of DTRC stacking rule 15.20 -15.20.1.
- Sample #14361 collected on September 23, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was returned positive for “Flunixin.” This sample was collected from “Cadillac Rose,” the winner of the 1st race on September 23, 2015. Raymond Handal, the trainer of record was informed of the positive at 10:20 a.m. on Saturday October 10, 2015. Trainer Handal waived his right to a hearing and will accept the penalty of a \$500.00 fine for a first offense of DTRC stacking rule 15.20 - 15.20.1.
- All samples collected on August 30, 2015 were cleared.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #2, “Pagan Joy,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 7

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Gustavo Larrosa scheduled to ride #5, “Maggies Dance,” was changed to Christian Dominguez; no double jocks mount. **INQUIRY AT THE START -** #6, “Knee Socks,” stumbled at the start unseating jockey Mario Rodriguez. The #6 horse was caught by the outriders after the race was over. Jockey Rodriguez was transported to first aid for evaluation. Mr. Rodriguez was examined at first aid by EMT Melisa Lancaster, who stated the jockey was cleared to continue riding. #5, “Maggies Dance,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 7

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. Nik Juarez, named on #2, “Hardrainsgonnafall,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. Mario Rodriguez scheduled to ride #4, “Alberta Clipper,” was changed to Angel Serpa; as Mr. Rodriguez was required to sit out one race by the Stewards. Daniel Centeno, named on #9, “My Red Cat,” was changed to Scott Spieth; no double jocks mount. #5, “Deputize,” was claimed by Nick Sanna Stables LLC – Michael Gorham. #6, “Unique Greatness,” was claimed by Bruno Schickendanz – Aldana Gonzalez. #7, “This Was Your Ring,” ridden by Augusto Marin pulled up lame after the race and then dismounted. The #7 was examined by Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown. Dr. Brown reported the horse was off in the right front and had the horse removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 4 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 9

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:45 p.m. Keiber Rengifo, named on #2, “Harley’s Joy,” was changed to Janelle Campbell; no double jocks mount. #4, “Flying Slew,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Harley’s Joy,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. After a three-way shake, #6, “Im Still Arockstar,” was claimed by Brandon Jones – Scott Lane. #5, “Bogelia,” ridden by Carol Cedeno, was pulled up by its rider at the ¼ pole and who then dismounted. The #5 was examined by Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who reported that the horse “Bogelia,” had suffered a right front sesamoid fracture, and was humanely destroyed.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 9 - 1.” Starters - 8

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #1, “Mettemarlamelva,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Becky Kecki,” and #4, “Sun Stricker,” were vet scratches. **INQUIRY AT THE QUARTER POLE -** The #1a, “Just Em,” with rider Brian Pedroza appeared to clip heels with #10, “Xtra Blue,” ridden by Alex Canchari. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. The horse, “Just Em” had gotten up and was caught by the outriders following the race. Jockey Pedroza was transported to first aid for evaluation. Mr. Pedroza was examined at first aid by EMT Melissa Lancaster, who reported the jockey was cleared to continue riding. #3, “Princess Akila,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 9 - 5.” Starters - 8

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. Brian Pedroza, scheduled to ride #6, “Calvello,” was changed to Alex Canchari; as Mr. Pedroza was required to sit out one race by the Stewards. #1, “Jonesy Boy,” was a vet scratch.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 6

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. Andrew Wolfsont, named on #4, “Sartorius,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. Vincent Gudiel, scheduled to ride #13, “All Day Sucker,” was changed to Scott Spieth; no double jocks mount. #5, “Northampton Kid,” #6, “Sloneker’s Star,” #7, “Stormy Alex,” #9, “Street Passage,” and #11, “Middle Road,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #14, “Blast Away,” was scratched as an alternate. #3, “Eye of the Moon,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
