SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m. #4, “Vince’s Valentina,” and #8, “Make Big Money,” were scratched as main-track only. #6, “Miss Well Molded,” and #10, “Baby Situation,” were scratched by the racing office.

INQUIRY IN MID STRETCH - Hold and claim of foul by the trainer of the #1, “Antia,” M C Reardon against the #12, “Miss Giacomo,” ridden by Antonio Gallardo. The rider of the #1, “Antia,” Vince Halliday claimed foul after coming back and talking to the trainer. The claim of foul was in reference to the #12, “Miss Giacomo,” coming over and brushing the #1, “Antia,” during the stretch run allegedly causing jockey Halliday to steady his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official as the #12, “Miss Giacomo,” came in during the stretch run, but did not bother the #1.
