Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Associate Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts is substituting for Dr. John Peters.

Administrative Hearings:

Hearing held on Tuesday, October 13, 2015 for trainer Mr. Ramon Preciado for his "Clenbuterol," positive, for the horse "Jake N Elwood," who was the winner of the third race on Saturday, September 12, 2015. The Stewards issued Mr. Preciado a seven-day suspension a \$500.00 dollar fine and the disqualification of the horse "Jake N Elwood" from all purse monies. Mr. Preciado has indicated that he will appeal the Stewards decision to the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission.

On Tuesday, October 13, 2015 we tested 1 trainer, 1 groom and 1 exercise rider/assistant starter who tested positive for marijuana. We also tested 1 jockey who tested positive for cocaine. The subjects all waived their right to a formal hearing and were suspended pending evaluation and recommendation from a Drug and Alcohol counselor, before a reinstatement hearing will be considered.

Today we tested 1 groom and 1 jockey both tests were clear.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Sample #15393 collected on September 26, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was returned positive for "Phenylbutazone and Flunixin." This sample was collected from "Make Big Money," the winner of the 3rd race on September 26, 2015. Jorge Rodriguez the trainer of record was informed of the positive at 10:20 a.m. on Tuesday, October 13, 2015. Trainer Rodriguez has waived his right to a hearing and will accept the penalty of a \$500.00 fine for a first offense of DTRC stacking rule 15.20 -15.20.1.

- Sample #15135 collected on September 26, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was returned positive for “Phenylbutazone and Flunixin.” This sample was collected from “Silk n’ Sequins,” the winner of the 5th race on September 26, 2015. Alejandro Reyes the trainer of record was informed of the positive at 10:20 a.m. on Tuesday, October 13, 2015. Trainer Reyes has waived his right to a hearing and will accept the penalty of a \$500.00 fine for a first offense of DTRC stacking rule 15.20 -15.20.1.
- Samples #16100, #15371, and #15119 collected on 9-26-15 and were placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, were cleared.
- Sample #15167 collected on 9-28-15 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis was cleared.
- All out of competition samples for October 2015 were cleared.
- Samples collected on October 3, 2015 are clear, with the exception of #15374 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- All samples collected on October 5, 2015 were cleared.
