Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

We held movies today for the second race, from Saturday, May 30, 2015. The riders involved in the incident for the movies were Mr. Augusto Marin and Mr. Kerwin Clark. After reviewing the films with the riders involved, the Stewards suspended Augusto Marin for 7 days for careless riding.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Victor Carrasco, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Street Car,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #3, “Sumo,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Coldblack,” was selected for a special post-race test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #1, “Dilatory,” and #6, “Half Strike,” were vet scratches. #4, “Dreaming of Andy A,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race, as we were below six betting interests. #3, “Normal Practice,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #3, “Normal Practice,” requested a \$113.00 all-inclusive special test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 5

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:21 p.m. #4, “Prospector’s Heart,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #4, “Prospector’s Heart,” requested a \$113.00 all-inclusive special test. We experienced a 5 minute delay in this race, as we had to send the outrider back to the paddock for a set of blinkers for the #1, “Nueshty,” It is noted that the blinkers that “Nueshty” wore had broken, and the blinkers kept at the starting gate were too small for the horse.

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:51 p.m.
This race was scheduled at seven and one half furlongs on the turf, but ran at one mile on the main track. Jose Ferrer, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Wowwhatabrat,” was changed to Carol Ceden; no double jocks mount. #1, “Waki Girl,” #7, “Gansett,” and #10, “Tarkia,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 12 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 11

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m. #3, “Shoutout,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Impressive Roberto,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race, as we were below six betting interests.

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m.

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 0:00 p.m. Starting with this race the remaining races were canceled due to lightning and heavy rains, making for unsafe racing conditions for horses and participants. *Alex Thomas, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Regal Revenge,” was changed to Christian Olmo; no double jocks mount. #6, “Grand Mast,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Grand Mast,” was selected for a special post-race test. We had a lightning strike at about 4:07 - 10 minutes to post with all power going out.*
