Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing this morning regarding the conditional groom's license that had been granted to Ms. Nancy Metz. On 6-1-15, Ms. Metz had thrown a water bucket and equipment bag at her trainer Ms. Aldana Gonzalez after the 4th race, in front of the betting public, for no apparent reason. Testimony was received from the trainer and witness to the incident. Subsequently, the Stewards decided to revoke the conditional license of Ms. Metz. Ms. Metz was allowed to gather her personal effects under the direction of Delaware Park security and left the premises in an orderly fashion. A ruling will be forthcoming.

During a hearing this morning concerning a financial dispute between trainer, Ms. Jackie Acksel and Simoff Horse Transportation it was determined that the trainer owed for a shipping bill during 2014 that was still outstanding. During the hearing, both parties came to an agreement that the debt for the horse transportation company would be paid.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from May 23, 2015 are clear with the following exceptions, samples #14207, #14260 and #14244 collected on May 23, 2015, are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- All Samples from May 25, 2015 are clear with the following exception, #14238, collected on May 25, 2015, is on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Due to a racing office error, the rider Yomar Orlando Ortiz,; on the #3, “Seriously Simon,” was changed to apprentice rider Jomar Ortega; no double jocks mount. #4, “Minor Crisis,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 4 - 6.” Starters – 7

THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #2, “Sunshine Heart,” was scratched as this race is off the turf. #3, “Our Laughing Lady,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Moon Vision,” was scratched for track conditions. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race, as we were below six betting interests. We experienced tote problems for this race, no result numbers for approximately 8 minutes.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 6 - 8.” Starters - 5

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:52 p.m. The main track was been downgraded to **SLOPPY** starting this race. #5, “Summer Cocktail,” was claimed by Phantom Racing Stables LLC – Wayne Potts. #7 “Savannah Mist,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Doc of the Card,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #3, “Bruin Belles,” was scratched by Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, as the horse had flipped in the gate injuring itself. The #4, “Sweet Anne Gold,” was also scratched by Dr. Brown for injuring itself as a chain reaction to the antics of the #3 horse. We experienced a 10 minute tote delay in making this race official. The Superfecta was canceled by tote, but it should not have been canceled.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 8 - 2.” Starters - 5

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. #1, “Moonshine Blues,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Tiznow True,” was scratched on account of track conditions. #7, “Half Wed,” was selected for a blood gas test. Due to the fact that these scratches occurred before wagering started, Superfecta wagering for this race, was canceled as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 5

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m. #1, “Street Passage,” #5, “Trib,” #8, “Hooping,” and #11, “Lefty Got It Right,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #14, “Northern Coyote,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Strike it Now,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 10 - 2.” Starters - 9

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. #1, “Fatum,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Allied Kid,” was selected for a special post-race test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 6 – 1a.” Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. Christian Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Tony Tile,” was changed to Mario Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. #2, “Dipping Diamonds,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Hammer Song,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START** - #7, “Hammer Song,” broke in at the start, bumping with the #6, “Discreet Reason,” and the #5, “Tony Tile,” broke out into the #6. The #7 then clipped the heels of the #6, unseating its rider, Scott Spieth. Jockey Spieth got up and signed a waiver of treatment form for the EMT’s before returning to the jockey’s quarters. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. #8, “Antares,” was selected for a special post-race test. After a tree-way shake, #6, “Discrete Reason,” was claimed by John Volpe – Owner Trainer.
