Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 4, 2012, for Trainer Javier Velez. The hearing was for failure to have an up to date negative Coggins test certificate, for the horse "March Ink" which resulted in a scratch in the third (3rd) race on Thursday, August 23, 2012. As a result of the hearing, trainer Velez will be fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for this violation.

We held a telephonic hearing on Tuesday, September 4, 2012, for Trainer, Varsamis Barbalios. The hearing was for failure to have an up to date negative Coggins test certificate, for the horse "Zany Viola" which resulted in a scratch in the fifth (5th) race on Saturday, August 25, 2012. As a result of the hearing, trainer Barbalios will be fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for this violation.

A hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, September 4, 2012, for Exercise Rider Terry Terrio, for threatening a trainer and testing positive for Marijuana. Mr. Terrio did not show up for the scheduled hearing, and will be suspended indefinitely pending a hearing before the Stewards.

Administrative:

An Assistant Trainer test was administered by the Stewards to Mr. John Meehan on September 5, 2012. Mr. Meehan is currently licensed as a horse owner. Mr. Meehan did not pass the assistant trainers exam.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #4, “A Credible Threat,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Harvard,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 3 - 2.” Starters - 5**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #1a, “Avarice,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #7, “Forest Diva,” was scratched by the racing office. #4, “Big Belief,” was selected for a blood gas test. The main track has been downgraded to GOOD starting this race, due to rain. #4, “Big Belief,” Javier Santiago, stumbled at the start. A hold was placed on the race by the rider of the #3, “Waytogo Trish,” Alex Cintron, shortly after the start. No Inquiry or claim of foul was lodged in this race. The #5, “Really Seriously,” ridden by Joe Rocco Jr., came in shortly after the start, but the #3, “Waytogo Kris,” Alex Cintron came out at the same time. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #3, “Debit Card,” and #5, “One Ocean Drive,” were vet scratches. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 6 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 5**

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m. Martin Solis, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Danger Angel,” was changed to Yomar Orlando Ortiz; double jocks mount will be charged. #3, “Chilkoot Trail,” was scratched by the trainer. #6, “Treaty Notice,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #1, “Werbee,” #7, “Cusabo,” and #8, “Distinctive Alibi,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #11, “Hard Drive,” was scratched as an alternate. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 10 - 9 - 5.” Starters - 5**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. Abel Castellano Jr., the scheduled rider on the #5, “Little Pinkie,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. #3, “E. T. Indy,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Charli Sunshine,” was selected for a blood gas test. Due to a mistake by the racing office, the #5, “Little Pinkie,” should be in for the allowance conditions, not the \$16,000 claiming price. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 6**
