

*A report from LGC Science, Inc., the official Chemists of the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission, showed that the blood sample #50575, taken from the horse "Target Sighted", who finished first in the second race on Monday, August 25, 2014, tested positive for "Phenylbutazone" in the amount of 3.7 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. The trainer of this horse, Mr. Thomas Iannotti IV, SS# ***-**-1975, DOB 12/05/1973, waived his right to a split sample.*

Mr. Iannotti waived his right to a hearing and under the authority of the Stewards, refer to D.T.R.C. 3.3.1, 3.3.3, 3.3.10, 3.4.1, 3.4.1.7. Mr. Iannotti was found to be in violation of D.T.R.C. Rules 7.3.1, 7.3.6, 7.3.9, 10.8.1, 10.8.1.3, 15.1, 15.1.1.1, 15.1.1.2, 15.1.2.2, 15.1.2.6, 15.1.2.7, 15.1.3.1, 15.1.3.1.1, 15.1.3.1.2, 15.1.3.1.3, 15.1.3.1.4, 15.1.3.1.5, 15.3.1. Mr. Iannotti for a first offense is fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. This Violation shall incur One (1) Point towards the ARCI Medication point system. Refer to D.T.R.C. Rules 3.3, 3.4 and 3.4.1.15. Fine must be paid within 48 hours.
