Stewards Ruling*

(64-2012)

*A report from Dalare Associates, Inc., the official Chemists of the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission, showed that the blood sample D-08086, taken from the horse "Embracing Hearts", who finished first in the sixth race on Monday, August 27, 2012, tested positive for "Phenylbutazone" in the amount of 2.74 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. The trainer of this horse, Mr. Julio Cartagena, SS#***-**-5753, DOB 10/09/1957, waived his right to a split sample.*

As a result of the positive, Mr. Cartagena waived his right to a hearing. Under the authority of the Stewards, refer to D.T.R.C. 3.3.1, 3.3.3, 3.3.10, 3.4.1, 3.4.1.7. Mr. Cartagena was found to be in violation of D.T.R.C. Rules 7.3.1, 7.3.6, 7.3.9, 10.8.1, 10.8.1.3, 15.1, 15.1.1.1, 15.1.1.2, 15.1.2.2, 15.1.2.6, 15.1.2.7, 15.1.3.1, 15.1.3.1.1, 15.1.3.1.2, 15.1.3.1.3, 15.1.3.1.4, 15.1.3.1.5, 15.3.1. Mr. Cartagena for a first offense is fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. Refer to D.T.R.C. Rules 3.3, 3.4 and 3.4.1.15. Fine must be paid within 48 hours.
