



A report from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc., the official Chemists of the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission, showed that the blood sample 15135, taken from the horse "Silk N' Sequins", who finished first in the fifth race on Monday, September 28, 2015, tested positive for "Phenylbutazone" and "Flunixin". The Trainer of this horse, Mr. Alejandro Reyes, RCI Id 2017216, DOB 6/17/1948, waived his right to a split sample.


Mr. Reyes, waived his right to a hearing and under the authority of the Stewards, refer to D.T.R.C. 3.3.1, 3.3.3, 3.3.10, 3.4.1, 3.4.1.7, Mr. Reyes was found to be in violation of D.T.R.C. Rules 7.3.1, 7.3.6, 7.3.9, 10.8.1, 10.8.1.3, 15.1, 15.1.1.1, 15.1.1.2, 15.1.2.6, 15.1.2.7, 15.1.3.1, 15.1.3.1.1, 15.1.3.1.2, 15.1.3.1.3, 15.20 and 15.20.1 And is hereby fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for stacking. This Violation shall incur One (1) Point towards the ARCI Medication point system. Refer to D.T.R.C. Rules 3.3, 3.4 and 3.4.1.15. Fine must be paid within 48 hours.
